



SITRUSOEWER RIVER CAMP

We offer four self-catering cabins, each sleeping a family of four. All cabins have their own bathrooms, aircons, roof fans, as well as heaters for the cold nights. There are no stoves in the cabins, however, there is a two plate stove in the communal kitchen for cabin guests. We suggest you bring your own pots and pans.

Cabins are finished off with reeds for a rustic feel and are equipped with a kettle, fridge, microwave, electric frying pan, toaster, casserole, braai equipment, crockery and cutlery. We provide bedding for all four cabins, but guests must please bring their own towels. We supply enough toilet paper and shower soap for 2 days as well as dishwashing liquid and dish towels for all cabins. No Wifi and no TV's in cabins! Here we still talk to each other!

Cabins

Blue Crane cabin (with aircon) can accommodate 4 people in total. It has a separate bedroom with double bed and wardrobe and a double sleeper couch in the living room, as well as a 4 seater dining room table and kitchen sink. It has its own bathroom with shower and a roofed patio with braai.

Fish Eagle (with aircon): is the only cabin suitable for a **family** of 5 (there will be extra costs for more than 3 adults), with a large roofed patio and braai. It now has a separate bedroom with queen size bed, wardrobe and dressing table as well as a single bed and in the original room, another 2 single beds. It also has a kitchen sink for washing dishes, a 6 seater dining table with chairs and its own bathroom with shower.

Kingfisher, (with aircon): with separate bedroom and a queen-sized bed. There is also a bunk bed (not suitable for 2 adults) in the original room which sleeps 2 children, so the cabin comfortably sleeps a family of four. The renovations include a bathroom with a shower, toilet and basin. It has a private deck on the water with an open braai and sink for dishes. We supply shower soap and dishwashing liquid and enough toilet paper for 2 days. Due to the proximity to the water, this cabin is not recommended for families with small children. You can bring your own outdoor umbrella for the deck. There is a hole in the table as well as umbrella stand.

Kiepersol (with aircon) also accommodates 4 people and has a separate bedroom with double bed and wardrobe and en-suite bathroom. In the living room are 2 single beds. It has a small patio with bench, table, braai and sink attached to the outside wall to wash dishes. Guests are welcome to use the communal kitchen next to the large ablution.

NB - Unfortunately no pets and no smoking allowed in cabins!

Camping

We also have camping sites with power points available. Campers can make use of the lapa with bar and braai area, communal ablutions and kitchen, which is equipped with a fridge, a microwave, a kettle, a two plate stove. With easy access to the river, it's an ideal spot for fishing, swimming and bird watching. Loads of outdoor fun for children with a play park area, canoes, tubes and pool noodles! If you are using a **plastic tent during our hot summer months**, please bring a **protective groundsheet** to prevent the grass from burning.

2026 Rates

(All camping sites have normal power points)

Cabins must be booked for minimum 2 nights, 3 nights over long weekends and 7 nights over festive season. (cabin special during the week, excluding school and public holidays: stay for 4 week nights and only pay for 3)

Blue Crane: R950/night

Fish Eagle: R1 000/night, more than 3 adults: R1 100/night

Kingfisher: R1 000/night

Kiepersol: R900/night

Camping: R160/adult and R100/scholar/night (Scholars: gr 1 – gr 12 and pre-school: free) Minimum R200/site if only 1 person on a site.

Day visitors: R90/adult, R50/scholar from 9am – 5pm

Wood: R50/bag **Ice:** R25/bag

Times of arrival: 14:00 cabins and 12:00 camp sites

Times of departure: 10:00 cabins and 11:00 campsites

Please keep to these times during the holiday season!

Sitrusoewer River Camp Rules

- Entry into any orchards without permission is strictly prohibited. Picking fruit is not allowed under any circumstances. Our orchards are for export use only — please ensure that your children also respect this rule.
- Entry to the premises and use of all facilities are entirely at your own risk.
- Ground sheets are **compulsory** during the December holidays and summer months for all tents, to help protect the grass.
- **Day visitors** are only allowed with prior arrangement, and an additional fee applies.
- All outstanding fees will be collected at the camp. No check-in is needed if your booking has been made in advance.
- **Braai wood** is available for purchase on request — please order enough on your booking form.
- Please be considerate of fellow campers and keep the bathrooms and communal areas clean.
- This is a peaceful getaway for **nature lovers**, not a party venue. Loud music and drunken behaviour are not allowed. Please report any disturbances.
- The **lapa** is available to all overnight guests unless it has been pre-booked by a group.
- **Dustbins** are provided throughout the camp — please use them and not the river or grass areas.
- Our **water and electricity** supply is limited — please use both sparingly. Switch off lights when not in use.
- Ensure that your children do not disturb the birdlife or wildlife.
- **Fishing is strictly catch-and-release only.**
- **Small breed dogs** are allowed by prior arrangement only. They must remain at your site or be kept on a leash at all times. Cleaning up after your pet is compulsory.
- **Canoes and paddle skis** are free to use, but please remove them from the water after use or if they are leaking.
- **No diving** in the river — there are many shallow spots that can be dangerous.
